Directions to E31 - Sandhills Holiday Park Peacock Hill, Whitecliff Bay, Bembridge, Isle of Wight



Public House 1, Nab Bar (*Bar & Restaurant*) - PH2, The Crab & Lobster Inn (*Bar & Restaurant*)
PH3, Pilot Boat Inn (*Bar & Restaurant*) - PH4, Ye Olde Village Inn (*local Bar with Food*)
PH5, Propeller Inn (*Bar & Restaurant*) - PH6, Culver Haven Inn (*Bar & Restaurant*)

Driving

From Fishbourne (Wightlink from Portsmouth - about 35 minutes) - turn right out of the terminal, then left at the traffic lights onto the A3054 towards Ryde. At Ryde, do not turn left (Queens Road) where signposted to Sandown. Continue straight on (50 yds) then first left (Argyll St) - signposted 'All Through Traffic'. Continue until the T junction and turn right - A3055 towards Brading and Sandown. Pass through Brading and turn left at the traffic lights/*Yarbridge Inn* crossroads. Over the narrow River Yar bridge and continue on B3395 past the *Propeller Inn* on the left. Slow down and, as the road bends to the left, turn right and then after a few yards, right again into Peacock Hill - by the duck pond. Sandhills entrance is about 100 yards on the left. Caravan E31, with the terracotta colour roof and adjacent to some black & white bollards, is almost opposite the reception and shop.

Driving From East Cowes (Red Funnel from Southampton - about 55 minutes) drive straight out of the ferry terminal and stay on this road - it becomes the A3021. After about 3 miles, at the roundabout, take the left turn onto the A3054 towards Ryde. At Ryde, do not turn left (Queens Road) where signposted to Sandown. Continue straight on (50 yds) then first left (Argyll St) - signposted 'All Through Traffic'. Continue until the T junction and turn right - A3055 towards Brading and Sandown. Pass through Brading and turn left at the traffic lights/*Yarbridge Inn* crossroads. Over the narrow River Yar bridge and continue on B3395 past the *Propeller Inn* on left. **Slow down** and, as the road bends to the left, turn right and after a few yards, right again into Peacock Hill just by the duck pond. Sandhills entrance is about 100 yards on the left. Caravan E31, with the terracotta colour roof and adjacent to black & white bollards, is almost opposite the reception shop.

Driving From Yarmouth (Wightlink from Lymington - about 30 minutes) turn left out of the ferry terminal (the A 3054) and follow this road for about 10 miles to Newport. At the A3020 roundabout, turn right onto the dual carriageway and stay in the left hand lane. Take the second left or, if you miss it, the next left at the roundabout - towards Ryde (still the A3054). At Ryde, do not turn left (Queens Road) where signposted to Sandown. Continue straight on (50 yds) then first left (Argyll St) - signposted 'All Through Traffic'. Continue until the T junction and turn right - A3055 towards Brading and Sandown. Pass through Brading and turn left at the traffic lights/*Yarbridge Inn* crossroads. Over the narrow River Yar bridge and continue on B3395 past the *Propeller Inn* on left. Immediately **Slow down** and, as the road bends to the left, turn right and after a few yards, right again into Peacock Hill just by the duck pond. Sandhills entrance is about 100 yards on the left. Caravan E31, with terracotta colour roof and adjacent to the black & white bollards, is almost opposite the reception and shop.

Foot Passengers Via Southampton Station to West Cowes Terminal

(www.redfunnel.co.uk) catch Red Funnel's Hi-Speed passenger ferry (Red Jet) to West Cowes. Crossing time approximately 22 minutes - no toilets on board. At West Cowes, there is a taxi rank in Fountain Yard or buses run from the ferry terminal or Cowes Co-op nearby. Southern Vectis Bus Service (www.islandbuses.co.uk.info) provides through connections to Bembridge via Newport or Ryde and then to Sandhills on the route to Sandown. Alight at the duck pond and walk up Peacock Hill to Sandhills. This is a very infrequent bus service so we strongly suggest you consider using; **Village Taxis - Tel: 01983 874470 or Bembridge Harbour Taxis - Tel: 01983 874132.**

Via Portsmouth Harbour Station to Ryde Pier Head (www.wightlink.co.uk)

Catch Wightlink's high speed passenger service (FastCat) at the far end of Portsmouth Harbour train platform and cross the Solent to Ryde Pier in about 15 minutes - toilets are provided onboard. From Ryde Pier Head you can catch the train to Brading then a number 1 bus to Whitecliff Bay or the train to Sandown Station and then a No. 10 or 12 bus back to Whitecliff Bay. Alight at the duck pond and walk up Peacock Hill to Sandhills. This is a very infrequent bus service so we strongly suggest you consider using; **Village Taxis - 01983 874470 or Bembridge Harbour Taxis - 01983 874132.**

A taxi to sandhills from Ryde Pier Head (about £12- £14 for up to 4 passengers and luggage) is probably the best option. Get a price and book the taxi before leaving Portsmouth. Disembark from the FastCat, through the double doors and the taxi could then be waiting to take you door-to-door. You could also get the train to Brading and then a taxi (about £6-£7) or on to Sandown and then back to Sandhills by taxi (about £8).

Via Portsmouth & Southsea Station to Ryde (www.hovertravel.co.uk)

Catch Hovertravel's hovercraft passenger service. Cross over to Ryde in about 5 minutes. You then have the same train, bus and taxi options as above. Have a good journey.
